

## **Request for Sealed Bids for Electrician Services for the Ross County Fairgrounds**

The Ross County Agricultural Society will be accepting sealed bids until June 1, 2018. Bid documents must be mailed to Ross County Agricultural Society, P.O. Box 614, Chillicothe, Ohio 45601 and must be post marked no later than June 1, 2018. Bid documents should include proof of Liability Insurance Coverage for no less than one million dollars, a current Bureau of Workers Compensation Certificate and a valid State of Ohio Electrical License.

Electricians must have experience with 7,200 volt primary electrical grid with both pole and pad mounted transformers and experience in repair of 120/240 volt secondary electrical grid. Electrical contractor will be required to provide all hand tools needed for installations and repairs. The Ag Society will furnish all materials.

At present, the Ross County Agricultural Society is requesting bids for two separate needs:

### **BID #1:**

This bid is for work to be performed prior to, during and immediately following the 2018 Ross County Fair. Work will consist of repairs to the 7200 volt primary grid and 120/240 secondary grid as needed. Installation of temporary services at mobile sites where needed. Repairs to permanent electrical outlets, lighting and RV camping outlets, breakers and other work as needed and directed by the Ag Society's designee responsible for the electric service on the grounds.

A minimum of two certified journeymen electricians will need to be present on the grounds beginning at 8:00 am, August 2, 2018, until 1:00 pm, August 12, 2018, to respond to and repair any and all electrical needs on the grounds. Electricians will be notified of outages and repairs needed by the Ross County Fair Board Office, Ross County Sheriff's Department and/or fair board members via two-way radios or in person.

Electrical contractor will have the ability to work out of the Ag Society electrical shop, will have use of a currently certified society owned bucket truck and three motorized golf carts and hand held radios. Two RV camping spots will be provided and any necessary gate passes as approved the society representative.

**BID #2:**

This bid is for work needed outside the dates of the Ross County Fair. The Ross County Agricultural Society wishes to have electrician services on both a scheduled and emergency basis throughout the year. Please provide an hourly rate for a certified journeyman electrician on a scheduled work basis and on an emergency basis. Please list any differences in rate for work performed on the two separate grids specified above, should there be any. Also, please provide the hourly rate for electrician helpers or apprentices who may also provide service.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for May 22, 2018, at 1:00 pm on the grounds of the Ross County Fair to review the bid specification and to view the two power grids.
